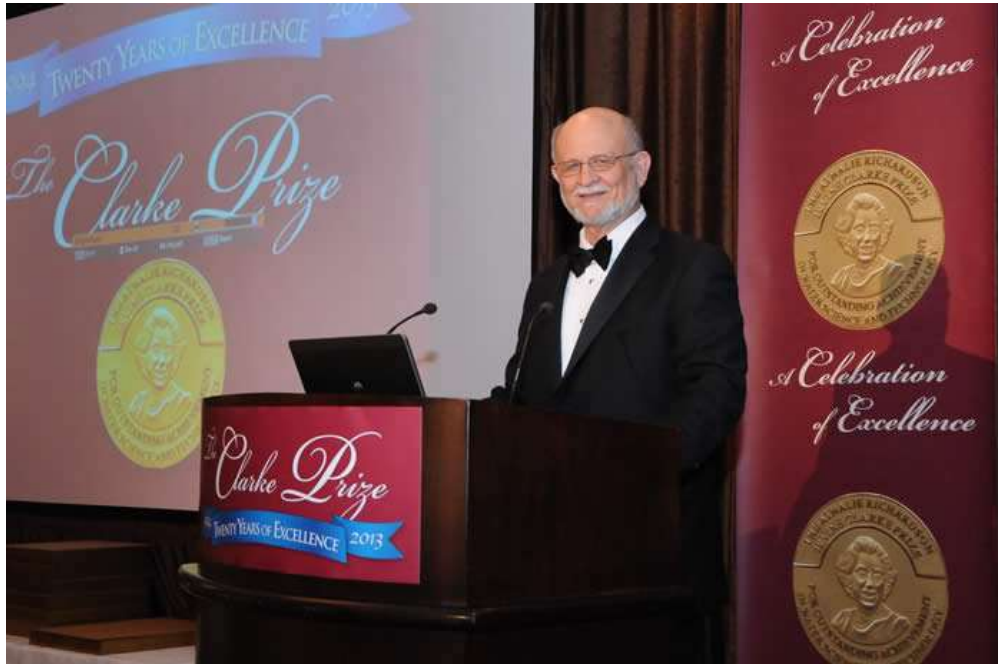


## Photos from the 2013 Award Ceremony and Lecture



The 2013 recipient of the Athalie Richardson Irvine Clarke Prize was environmental engineer R. Rhodes Trussell, Ph.D., P.E., BCEE, NAE, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer at Trussell Technologies, Inc. in Pasadena, California.



NWRI established the Clarke Prize in 1993 to honor outstanding individuals who have implemented better water science research and technology. The Clarke Prize--a medallion and \$50,000 award--is presented annually.



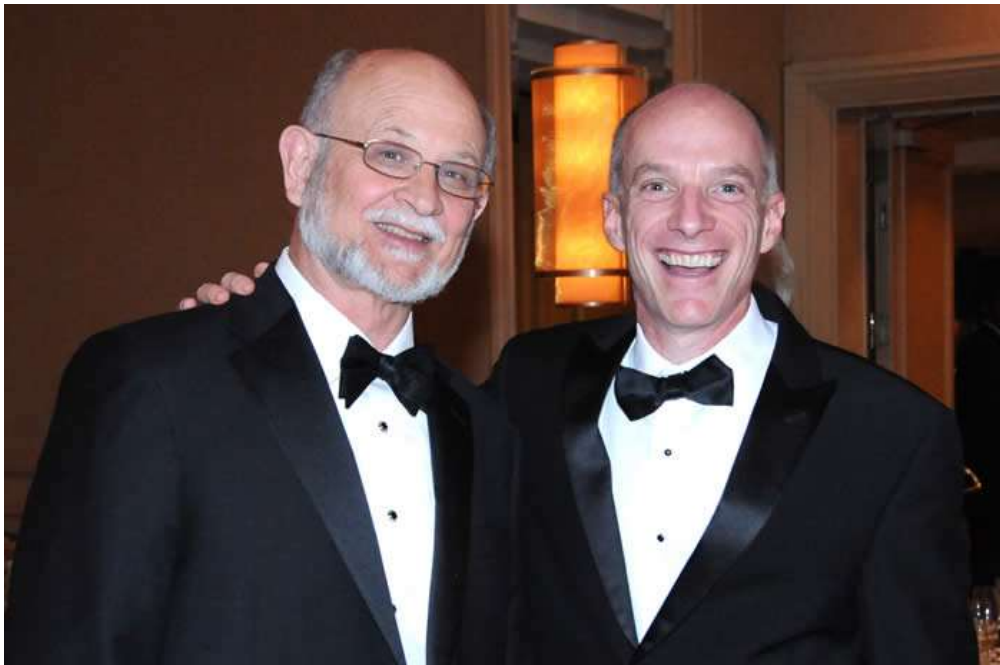

The 2013 honoree Rhodes Trussell received recognition for his achievements from Chair Nancy Sutley of the White House's Council of Environmental Quality, Bob Perciasepe of the EPA, Ralph Cicerone of the National Academy of Sciences, senators and representatives from California, and leaders at U.S. universities and water research organizations.

As part of the Twentieth Anniversary Celebration, NWRI honored the Joan Irvine Smith and Athalie R. Clarke Foundation with a tribute featuring a Clarke Medallion, a list of all 20 prize recipients, and a thank you letter recognizing the Foundation's outstanding support of the Clarke Prize for the last 20 years. The Foundation has provided \$1 million in funding since the Clarke Prize was established in 1994. 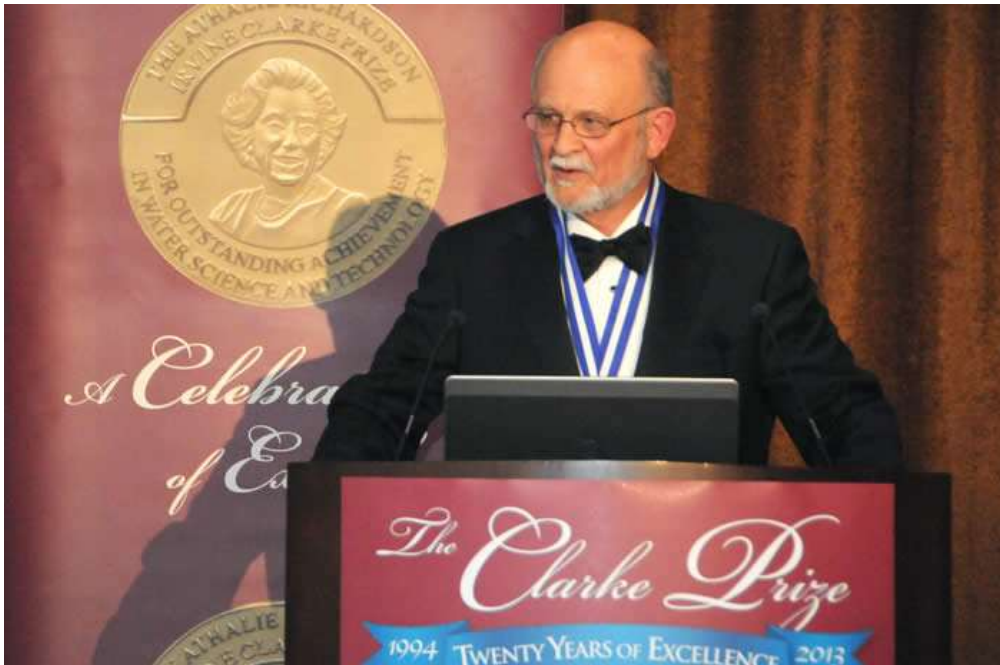
