Asset Management Training Workshops Now Available in Northern and Southern California

NWRI and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency will be holding "hands on" advanced asset management training workshops in Northern and Southern California to help improve the asset management assessment skills of water and wastewater utilities.

One training workshop will be held in Los Angeles in April 2010 and the other will be held in Oakland in June 2010.

Each training workshop includes:

- **Real-world storylines** to demonstrate advanced asset management as a way to approach difficult asset problems.
- **Participant exercises** to provide experience with the concepts, techniques, and tools of advanced asset management.
- **Case-based mentoring** with asset management experts.
- **Step-by-step demonstration** of how an agency would select and deploy best appropriate advanced asset management practices.

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Division of Drinking Water and Environmental Management Operation Certification Unit will provide up to fourteen (14) Continuing Education Units (Cues) for workshop participants. State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Clean Water Program Cues are pending.

For the Southern California region, the asset management training workshop will be held on April 21-22, 2010, at the City of Los Angeles Bureau of Sanitation in Los Angeles, California.
